Registration & Fees

Camp Rules

- No PDA (hand holding, kissing, hugging, arms around each other, etc.)

- No fighting, horseplay, bullying, teasing, pranks, etc. (We have a zero tolerance policy for these things)
- No DVD players, cd players, handheld electronic games etc.
- No cell phones (if you bring a cell phone we will be asking you to turn it over for the remainder of camp and will return it to you upon departure)
- No pictures to be taken inside cabins or bathrooms
- Any teen campers who drive will be required to turn in their car keys to the camp director at registration. If you need to leave for any reason you must clear that with your cabin dean and or the camp director
- All campers who drive will be asked to park their cars in the designated area in the back of the main building
- All campers must shower daily
- Girls are not permitted to be in the boys cabin area
- Boys are not to be in the girls cabin area
- No profanity, tobacco use (smoking, chewing, snuff) or illegal drugs, pornographic material
- All medications will be kept and dispensed by qualified camp staff unless it is approved for emergency purposes (inhalers, epi-pens, etc.)
- Campers are expected to be on time for all activities

Dress Code

- Shorts to the knee are permitted for daytime wear
- No tank tops, sleeveless shirts or dresses, wife beaters etc. are permitted
- Girls will wear dresses/skirts to the knee for evening church services
- Girls may wear leggings under knee length dresses
- NO yoga pants, leggings, or jeggings are permitted
- Boys will wear long pants or jeans to evening church services
- Boys are not to wear sweat pants except for sleeping in the cabins
- No clothing with inappropriate wording or pictures are permitted
